## **Some Future Honor/Memory Tree Candidates**



Brandywine Red Maple-Acer rubrum 'Brandywine' 40' tall, brilliant red-purple in autumn. It produces only male flowers so there are not fruits or nuisance seedlings.



Sun Valley Red Maple-Acer rubrum 'Sun Valley' 30 ft tall. orange-red fall color. Sun will bring out the full intensity of the fall colors.



Sugar Maple-Acer saccharin 70' tall. Beautiful orange-red in fall. Tolerates shade. Native Americans taught the early colonists how to tap the trees to make maple syrup



**Yellowwood**-Cladrastis kentukea. 40' tall. Fragrant pink.



Cherokee Princess Dogwood-Cornus florida '30' tall, white flowers, attracts birds, good fall foliage color.



Winter King Hawthorn-Crataegus viridis 'Winter King' 30' tall. White flowers, red fruit. The stems are mostly spineless. The fruit is edible but usually left for the birds.



**Skyline Honeylocust**-*Gleditsia triacanthos* 'Skyline'
40' tall, white flower, the leaves turn bright yellow in the fall.
The stems are thornless.



Sweet Bay Magnolia-Magnolia virginiana. 30' tall, fragrant, attracts butterflies and birds, cream white flowers have light lemon scent.



**Black Gum**-*Nyssa sylvatica* 40' tall. Stately tree with good fall color. Has small greenishwhite flowers.



**Bloodgood London Planetree** *Platanus x acerifolia*'*Bloodgood*'
90' tall, shade tree. Attracts
birds. Attractive bark



Canada Red Cherry- Prunus virginians 'Shubert' 25' tall, maroon leaves, white flowers, attracts birds & butterflies. Leaves slowly turn purple as they mature.



Okame Cherry-Prunus X 'Okame'
20' tall. Reddish pink flowers bloom earlier than most cherries.



Greenspire Lindnen-Tilia cordata 'Greenspire' 60' tall. Yellow fragrant flowers bloom very early followed by good, golden-yellow fall color.
