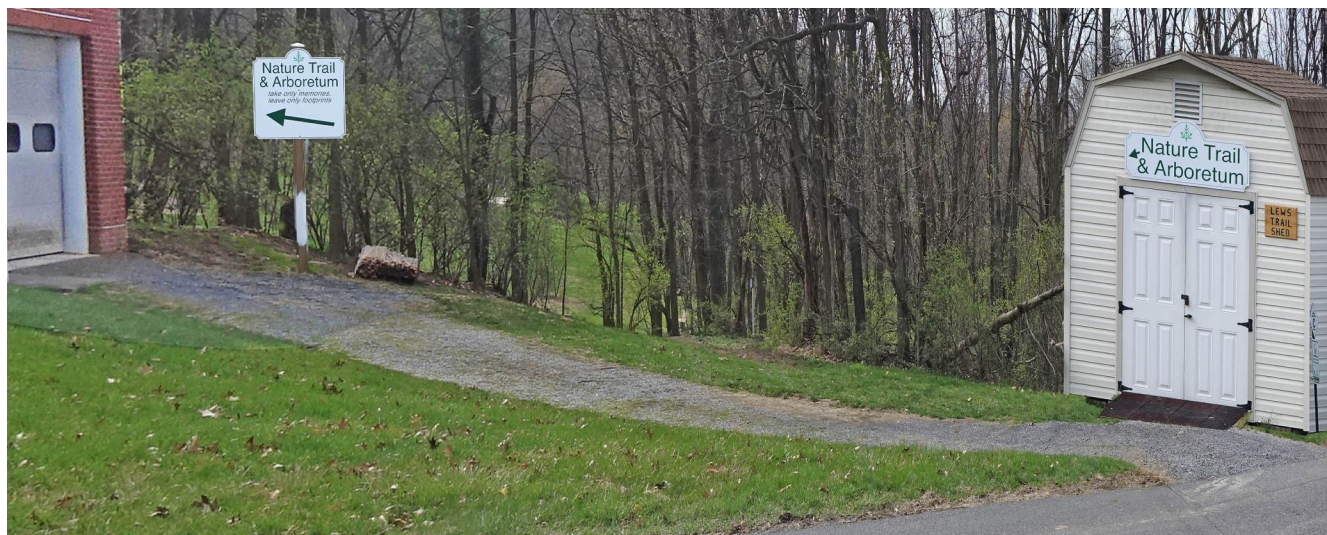

Woodcrest Villa Arboretum Is Dedicated to Those Recognized With Trees & Benches

For many residents, it has seemed that every route to the Nature Trail or Arboretum involved going either uphill or downhill. To address this, the Nature Trail & Arboretum Caretaker team (the trail crew) created an access trail that is nearly level—but it was not easy to find.

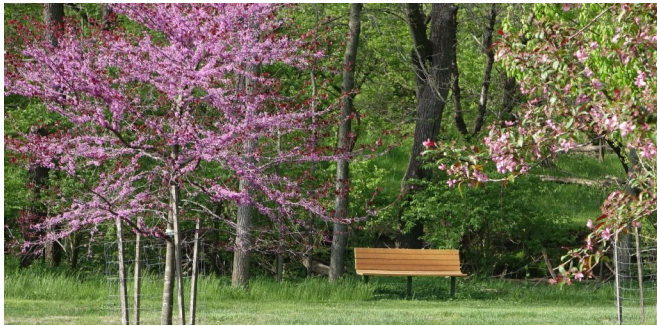
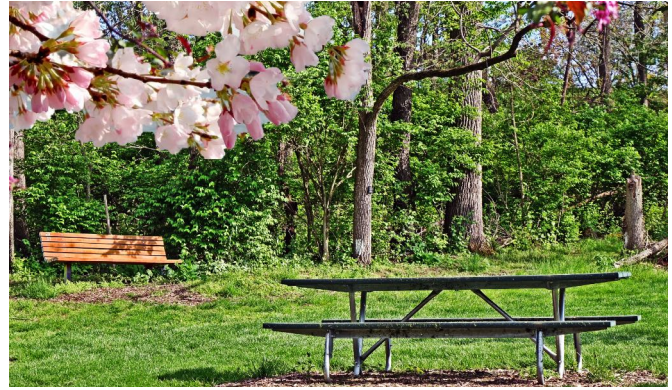
With the addition of new signage, this “flat trail” is now clearly marked and easy to access. The trail begins at Lew’s Trail Shed, located below Hummingbird, just past the bus garage. Convenient parking is available near the shed.

From there, the trail follows a gentle, nearly level path from the lower rear corner of the bus garage and to the nature trail. From there it is a very short distance to the Arboretum.

You’ll also find a couple of benches and a picnic table nearby—perfect spots to rest, relax, and enjoy the surroundings. (see next page)
